## STANDING ORDER 2019-02

## ESTABLISHING "END STAY DATE" PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 2019-01

Upon consideration of the notice filed in Miscellaneous Proceeding 19-00101 on January 28, 2019, by the United States Trustee and the United States Attorney, on behalf of the United States, stating that an appropriations act that restored Department of Justice funding had been enacted into law, as directed by Standing Order 2019-01; it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 1. The "End Stay Date" for Standing Order 2019-01 shall be January 28, 2019; and
- 2. The United States Trustee and the United States Attorney may request a status conference or seek other relief in Miscellaneous Proceeding 19-00101 if in this calendar year there is another lapse in appropriations for the Department of Justice or other departments, agencies, or instrumentalities of the United States that materially affects the ability of the United States to protect its interests or perform required functions before this Court.
- 3. The Clerk of Court shall promptly send notice of entry of this Standing Order to all Registered Users of this Court's CM/ECF filing system and shall post a copy of this order at each Division office and with other standing orders on the Court's website.
  The Clerk shall also post notice of entry of this Standing Order on the home page of the Court's website. To the extent that the offices of either the United States Trustee

or the United States Attorney provided notice of Standing Order 2019-01 to a pro se party with whom either is engaged in active litigation, the offices of either the United States Trustee or the United States Attorney, as applicable, shall provide notice of this Standing Order to such pro se party and file a Certificate of Service in any such case or adversary proceeding.
