ORDER RESCINDING STANDING ORDER 2020-01, AND AMENDING MLBR 3011-1 AND 3017-1

By this order and pending final adoption of the local rules amendments, the Court orders as follows:



PROCEDURE FOLLOWING FINAL DISTRIBUTION IN CHAPTER 7 OR CHAPTER 13 CASES


3. The title to MLBR 3017-1 is amended to reflect the rule does not apply to cases filed under Subchapter V. The new title of the rule is as follows:


